### STARLITE M/V ARCHER NOW SERVES MATNOG-ALLEN ROUTE

Starlite Ferries Inc. (Starlite), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Chelsea Logistics Holdings Corp. (CLC), saw the first trip of its vessel M/V Archer, a RoRo/Passenger vessel on the Matnog, Sorsogon - Allen, Northern Samar route in April 2018.

M/V Archer departed Roxas, Mindoro on Wednesday, April 18 at 6 p.m., for an overnight trip to Allen. Upon arrival at Allen port on Thursday at 6 a.m., M/V Archer and its crew were welcomed by former Mayor Rod Suan. On 11 a.m. of the same day, MV Archer made its maiden voyage from Allen to Matnog and the return trip from Matnog, which departed 2:30 pm.



Weighing 836 tons, M/V Archer is capable of transporting 788 passengers and 26 rolling truck cargos per trip. It is now scheduled to traverse the Matnog-Allen route every day with total of eight (8) trips from 6:00AM to 9:00PM.

M/V Archer is the fifth ship that Starlite acquired under its vessel modernization program. M/V Pioneer debuted in 2015 and three more vessels – M/V Reliance, M/V Eagle and M/V Saturn were built in 2016.

On November last year, CLC acquired 100% ownership of Starlite. Under the new management, Starlite is eyeing to be the leading marine mover of vital goods, cargo, and passengers in the Philippines.

To date, Starlite owns 14 RoRo/Passenger vessels.
