Mislattel Consortium Declared as Provisional 3rd Telco Player

**Background/Description of the Disclosure**

Chelsea Logistics Holdings Corp. and its parent company, Udenna Corporation, have partnered with China Telecommunications Corporation to formally bid as a consortium (Mislattel Consortium) for the New Major Player (NMP) in the Philippines' telecommunications market. Mislattel Consortium and two other aspiring telco players submitted their bid to the National Telecommunications Commission Selection Committee in the morning of November 7, 2018.

After the review process, on the same day, the National Telecommunications Commission named Mislattel Consortium as the provisional third telco player in the Philippines.

**Other Relevant Information**

Mislattel Consortium will have to undergo a 3-day verification process before being named as the final NMP.
