News on approval of transfer of ownership of Mislatel

**Background/Description of the Disclosure**

We refer to the articles published in various newspapers on February 7, 2019. The Senate's concurrence on House Concurrent Resolution 23 formalized the sale of the controlling interest of Mislatel to Udenna Corporation, China Telecommunications Corp. and to CLC. However, subsequent to such Senate concurrence, the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) instructed the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) to request the House to issue a formal declaration to the effect that the House does not object to said Senate Resolution. DICT Officer-in-Charge Eliseo Rio said that the DICT will wait for official acts from the Senate and the House before a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity can be issued to Mislatel.
