Clarification of News Report

We write with respect to the news article entitled "Mislattel group seeks common tower proposals" posted in BusinessWorld (Online Edition) on March 26, 2019. The article reported in part that:

"THE Mislattel consortium is seeking common tower proposals as the third telecommunications player moves forward with its rollout plan while waiting to receive a permit to operate and the frequencies from the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC).

In a newspaper bulletin on Monday, the group composed of China Telecommunications Corp., Udenna Corp., Chelsea Logistics Holdings Corp. (CLC) and Mindanao Islamic Telephone Company, Inc. (Mislattel) said it is asking common tower providers to submit their proposals to the company.

Mislattel Spokesperson Adel A. Tamano said in a mobile message on Monday they have received 'lots' of interest from common tower providers already, but they want to 'do it in an organized way.'

He added the company is supposed to have 1,200 towers this year and 1,800 towers next year, with a total of about 10,000 towers within five years. For the first year, the rollout will be focused on Metro Manila, Luzon and key cities in Mindanao and Visayas.

Mislattel committed to invest a cumulative total of P257 billion for its five years of monitored operations, to be used to deliver an average minimum broadband speed of 27 Megabits per second (Mbps) in its first year and 55 Mbps in the succeeding years."
